FROM AROUND THE WORLD

In China....in the mountains of southern Sichuan, 400 people with leprosy and their families are receiving medical and vocational services through the Liangshan Leprosy Project. An initiative of District 3450 (Hong Kong, Macau and Mongolia) launched by the Rotary Club of Hong Kong South more than a decade ago, it maintains nine centres with a full time staff of doctors, nurses and community development officers. Patient's relatives receive training in trades such as beekeeping, pig farming and embroidery. The effort is supported by the Kadoorie Charitable Foundation in Hong Kong.

In India....In many countries, buying new hearing aids is often cheaper than adjusting an old pair. When Peter Patel, an ear, nose and throat specialist from the Rotary Club of Birmingham England and Rekha Shetty of the Rotary Club of Madras met at the 2009 RI Convention in Birmingham, a discussion on that topic led to Operation Sound of Music. Patel collects used hearing aids from his patients and sends them to Rotarians in India. After technicians check them, the devices go to children whose families could not afford them otherwise. More than 3000 children have received hearing aids so far.
